## **The northernmost point**

Raw beauty, extreme seasons and the play of Arctic light - a trip to the North Cape region is something to write home about! If you want an experience of a lifetime, try a North Cape tour in the wintertime!

A few hours of daylight, perhaps streaks of sunlight on the horizon. And spectacular Northern Lights dancing across the Polar sky. Fascinating sights, excursions and activities.

### **ATTRACTIONS/EXCURSIONS**

#### **Hornvika - the North Cape Classic**

Duration: 4 hours. Capacity 4-40. Season: June-Sept  
Conquer the North Cape the classic way. Hike to the top of Europe as adventurers and royalty did in the past. Boat from Skarsvåg, historical exhibition, sampling of local food, entrance to the North Cape Hall and champagne to celebrate.

#### **The North Cape**

Duration: 3-4 hours. Capacity: 6000. Season: All year  
The North Cape is known as Europe's northernmost point, located at a latitude of 71°10'21". North Cape Hall, a tourist centre with a host of facilities - exhibitions, souvenir store, cafeteria and restaurant and restrooms. You can also enjoy a beautiful film from the local area, shown in the Super Videographer.

#### **Artico Ice Bar**

Duration: 30-60 min. Capacity: 50. Season: May-Sept  
A bar made of ice from the lakes of Magerøya Island.

#### **Bird Safari**

Duration: 3.5-4 hours. Capacity: 147. Season: April-Aug

Take advantage of your moment in the north to experience one of Europe's greatest and most accessible sanctuaries for Atlantic seabirds. Be dazzled by millions of birds breeding and living at the Gjesværstappan Nature Reserve.

#### **King Crab Safari by boat**

Duration: 3 hours. Capacity: 4-40. Season: April-Sept  
Enjoy deep sea rafting in the fjord of Sarnes and participate in catching your own King Crab. Learn about the history of this famous creature and how to prepare it.

#### **King Crab Safari by bus**

Duration: 2.5 hours. Capacity: 60. Season: All year  
We welcome you to experience King Crab live at our lavvo camp in Sarnes. Learn about the life of these famous creatures and how to prepare them.

#### **The North Cape Café Theatre**

Duration: 35 min. Capacity: 65. Season: June-Aug  
How on earth can you settle down and enjoy life at 71° North. A group of local young artists gives you the surprising answer. The show takes place in Perleporten Culture House.

#### **ATV Safari**

Duration: 1.5 - 3 hours. Capacity: 4-20.

Season: All year

Experience the island of Magerøya's unique nature, with many stops for photos at stunning viewpoints over the island and Honningsvåg.

#### **Guided Fishing Village Tour**

Duration: 3 hours. Capacity: 400 Season: All year  
Enjoy an excursion to nearby fishing villages.

Experience daily life and fishing activities in the local community. Visit the gallery "East of the Sun" and the "Christmas & Winter House".

#### Midnight expedition to the North Cape

Duration: 17 hours. Capacity: 20.

### Northern Lights Adventure at the North Cape

You will be going with a night convoy through rugged Arctic scenery and will be standing next to the globe, a famous landmark, overlooking the endless ocean, looking north, in search for the Aurora.
